**Position:** Henry SWCD is taking applications for a full-time position to promote, assist, and educate landowners for nutrient management planning and practices for the Western Lake Erie Basin. This position will work with farmers, landowners, agribusinesses, and government entities in Henry, Fulton, & Western Lucas Counties. This person is responsible to the Henry SWCD Board of Supervisors for general supervision and guidance. Day to day Supervisor will be by the Henry SWCD. Ohio Department of Agriculture will provide training for work priorities and guidance on agricultural pollution matters.

**Duties:**

- Assist landowner in developing nutrient management and manure management plans
- Assist landowners with proper manure and soil testing
- Consult SWCD staff to develop and implement meetings/workshops designed to reach farmers and livestock producers
- Serve as primary point of contact for investigation of complaints relating to agricultural sediment, manure pollution and applications
- Assist with coordinating and expediting state cost share programs through ODA or other agencies
- Provide technical and engineering field assistance to farmers/landowners and other agencies
- Provide assistance to the H2Ohio program for sign-up, verification of nutrient management practices, drainage structures and data management.
- Assume other duties and responsibilities deemed necessary by the Henry SWCD.
