

Henry County H2Ohio Updates

#Plant2021 is pretty well wrapped up and we have started verification of practices. We need you to call and schedule an appointment to complete this process.

Everyone will need

- o Crop by field
- o All nutrients that have been applied since last fall
- o This includes your wheat starter and top dress
- o If you cannot provide an as-applied map for your corn we will need the following
- o Rate of application PER FIELD ex. 10gallons
- o Product applied ex. 10-34-0
- o Bill or Proof of purchase of the product
- o If you have as-applied maps please make sure they are showing us the same information
- o We also need the record keeping info for each field. I have attached those documents again. If you have a document that is showing that info already you don't need to use those.

If you planted wheat to be harvested this year and still have a seed tag for it, please bring that.



OACI also has a certification that needs completed. You can log in to complete this at ohioaci.org or bring your username and password along with you and Abby will help you complete it.

Important Dates

March 31– Created OACloho.org profile

April 1– Signed verification forms for VNMP and fall applied nutrients

April 16—First payments go out if all paperwork is turned in and approved for VNMP development, fall applied nutrients and controlled drainage structures

May 21—Remaining payments sent out for VNMP development, fall applied nutrients and controlled drainage structures

***** Once you know your wheat survived the winter please let us know acres and locations*****

June 1– Begin turning in documentation for VNMP Implementation and spring applied nutrients

***** We do anticipate that we will need you to sign contract extensions but do not have this paperwork yet*****

September 1—All paperwork turned in for VNMP Implementation, spring applied nutrients and manure application turned in

September 15—Payments for spring practices start to get approved

October 15—ALL COVER CROPS SEEDED

ALL MANURE APPLICATIONS COMPLETE

March 15, 2022– All cover crops must be maintained
